Day 1 : Arrival and Discovering Vientiane's Hidden Gems

Day 2 : Exploring the Charm of Vang Vieng



Following breakfast, we'll tour the capital's landmarks including Wat Sisaket and Ho Prakeo. Then, we'll travel to Vang Vieng on Expressway 109, known for its remarkable karst landscape and undiscovered caves.

Upon arrival, we'll visit the historic Tham Chang caves and in the afternoon, we'll enjoy swimming in the blue lagoon at Tam Pou kham cave, explore at the Pha Namxay viewpoint on our return journey.

Day 3 : Unveiling the Beauty of Luang Prabang



Optional activities: Early morning hot air or Paramotor ride over Nam Song River for panoramic views of Vang Vieng's landscape and city (not included).

After breakfast, enjoy a traditional-tail boat ride on Nam Song River to admire the stunning landscapes and karst hills. Free time until transfer to the high-speed train to Luang Prabang by C82 at 14:01.

Upon arrival in Luang Prabang, transfer to your hotel for check-in, followed by a visit to Phousi Hill for a

view of the world heritage site. In the evening, visit Luang Prabang's Night Market to meet local traders selling ethnic minority handicrafts

Day 4 : Exploring the Splendor of the City and its Stunning Waterfall



After breakfast, visit the Royal Palace for Buddha statues and then head to Wat Mai, known for its rich decorations. Next, visit the 16th-century temple, Wat Xieng Thong, and enjoy the view where the Nam Khan River meets the Mekong.

At noon, head to the Kuang Si waterfalls to swim, explore, visit the Asiatic black bear rescue center, and relax before returning to Luang Prabang.
