Day 1: Arrival in Luang Prabang

Day 2: Unveiling Luang Prabang's Rich Tapestry



Start the day with breakfast at 8:30 am, followed by a visit to the Royal Palace, housing a significant collection of treasures, including Buddha statues.

Explore Wat Mai, a temple known for its elaborate design, then visit Hean Chan, a traditional wooden house, and the 16th-century golden city temple Wat Xieng Thong. Finally, enjoy a break at River View Café and have the rest of the day free for leisurely exploration

Begin your day with the authentic Laotian tradition of offering alms to monks. Explore the lively Morning Market before breakfast.

Next, journey to Kuang Si Waterfalls, pausing at the Hmong exhibition to discover tribal crafts and the



Hmong of life.

Upon reaching the falls, take a stroll through a small forest, visit the Asiatic Black Bear Center, and unwind with a dip in the refreshing lagoon.

Finally, return to Luang Prabang for the night.

Day 4: Roaming the Mighty Mekong Expedition



Our journey begins as we board a morning cruise ship at the busy port along the Mekong River in Laos. While on the cruise, our guide will provide insights into Lao history, culture, and more.
