Tour Itinerary

Day 1 : Arrival and Leisure



Welcome to Huay Xay. At 8:00 AM, you will meet our English tour guide with a welcome sign at Houay Xay immigration office (Lao border). Our guide will assist you to apply for the visa. Afterward you will take a vehicle and transfer to centrally located basic hotel and free at your leisure. Overnight at accommodation in Huay Xay

Day 2 : Gibbon Experience Commences



9 am: departure from the office Around 10 am: arrival at the village to meet your guides. Start a 3-hour hike dotted with approximately 10 ziplines to get to your tree house.

You will have a sandwich break during your trek. Around 1 – 2 pm: arrival at your tree house, relaxing time 3 pm: explore surrounding ziplines as well as the biggest tree in all of Lao! 5 pm: food is brought to you: dinner time is left up to you. The rest of the night is yours

Overnight on tree house accommodation.



Day 3 : Gibbon Adventure and Scenic route to Luang Namtha



6h30 - 7:00 am: guides will bring you tea and coffee

7 - 8 am: optional hiking and ziplining (visit the other tree house)

8 - 8h30 am: breakfast 9h30 - 10 am: leave your tree house, continue the trek for 3 hours (including 7 ziplines) through the National Park and over the Nam Nga River.

Around 12 – 1 pm: lunch break by the river. Relaxing time and optional swimming.



The car picks you up there except in the rainy season, as you must walk 1 hour more before pick up. Around 2 – 3 pm: continue to Luang Namtha.

Overnight at accommodation in Luang Namtha.

Day 4 : Landscape venture to Muang Sing



After early rise we'll visit the local market where tribes exchange their wares. We will take our private vehicle to Muang Singh. On the way, we will have a short visit at a Lantan village.

Day 5 : Discovering the Ethnological Treasures



Today we have planned a trek of half a day into the surrounding hills, visiting dwellings of the **Yao**, **Thai Lu** and **Ikho** en route. The walking is moderate and will be undertaken at an easy pace with plenty of stops.

Overnight at accommodation in Muang Sing.

Day 6 : Journey to Nam Kat Yorlapa





Following breakfast, we will set out from Muang Singh and travel to Na Tueu to board a train. Subsequently, we will proceed by road to reach Nam Kat Yorlapa by the end of today.

Day 7 : Traveling across the Rolling Hills to Nong Khiaw



In the morning, we'll take in the breathtaking views of Nam Kat Yorapa traveling to Nong Khiaw, a village inhabited by the distinctive Hmong people.

By late afternoon, we'll arrive in Nong Khiaw and explore caves, tribal villages, and ascend to Pha Som Nang Viewpoint for stunning views over the Ou River.

Day 9 : Scenic journey to Luang Prabang



After breakfast, you can enjoy village life and drive to Pak Ou village, where we board a wooden 'sampan' to cross the Mekong River and visit the Pak Ou caves.

We'll arrive in Luang Prabang by late afternoon, with time to relax and explore the world heritage town and Night Market if time permits.

Day 10 : Unveiling Luang Prabang's Treasures



Luang prabang the former royal capital, known for its ancient temples and romantic setting at the confluence of the Mek and Kane Rivers.The compact size of the peninsula makes it best explored on foot.

10:00 AM In the morning, we'll visit the National Museum, Wat Xieng Thong, Wat Sen, and Wat May. The afternoon is free for you to explore or relax on your own, maybe by climbing Phousi Hill for excellent views of the World Heritage city and the rivers.

Day 11 : Culinary Delights & Cascading Beauty



In the morning, you can join a traditional Lao ritual of offering food to monks. After breakfast, at 9:00 am, a vehicle will pick you up from your hotel and take you to Ban Muangkhai, a local village where you can enjoy a scenic elephant ride and feeding.

Then, we'll head to the beautiful Kuang Si waterfalls for swimming and a picnic lunch. Finally, we can visit a center where endangered black Asiatic bears are sheltered.

Day 12 : Journeying to Vangvieng



Free in the morning until transfer to the train station and take the electric train from Luang Prabang to Vang Vieng (1hrs). C91 12:52-13:44

Upon arrival take Tuk Tuk to hotel. This tiny village is settled between a spectacular spread of limestone karsts and is surrounded by green lush paddy fields. The terrace of your hotel offers splendid sun-sets amidst these magnificent natural settings.

Day 13 : Vang Vieng: Relaxation



The whole day is at leisure. You probably like to enjoy some excursions such as exploring the surrounding caves by bicycle, hiring a canoe, tubing or rafting.

Day 14 : Journeying to Vientiane's Charm



After breakfast this morning, we'll drive on the expressway to Vientiane. Vientiane is a peaceful town located on the banks of the Mekong River.

The city features oriental temples, shopping areas, and after freshening up, we'll visit the unique Buddha Park. Later, we can spend time strolling around the Vientiane night market.

Day 15 : Discovering Vientiane's Historic Heart



Vientiane is a charming riverside town with temples like Wat Sisaket, Wat Prakeo, and the grand That Luang Stupa. Don't miss the Arch of Triumph, the National Museum, and the morning market for shopping. In the evening, enjoy a leisurely stroll along the Mong River.
