Day 1: Arrival and Unveiling Vientiane



Upon arrival in Vientiane, you'll be taken to your centrally located hotel. In the afternoon, enjoy a sightseeing tour of the city, visiting attractions like the Victory Gate, Wat Sisaket, and the impressive That Luang Stupa. Explore the 'morning market' for souvenirs take a leisurely stroll along the Mekong River in the evening. You will stay Overnight at your accommodation in Vientiane.

Day 2 : Delving into Kong Lor Cave



After breakfast, we'll drive to the Lor Cave, renowned for its limestone cliffs and adventure activities like rock climbing and ziplining. The cave, stretching over eight kilometers, is traversed by the Nam Hin Boun River, creating a unique natural wonder in Southeast Asia. Visitors may also catch sight of rare birds, spiders, and bats within the cave. In the late afternoon, enjoy a leisurely stroll through nearby

villages to experience the serene rural life. You will stay Overnight at accommodation in Kong Lor.

Day 3: Enchanting Hin Boun



Today, we'll leave the city to experience the rural life along the Nam Hin Boun River valley in Khammouane province. This area is known for its stunning limestone formations, caves, underground rivers, and traditional villages. Tonight, we'll stay in charming Lao-style wooden bungalows. In the evening, you can enjoy the soothing serenade of cicadas. You will stay Overnight at accommodation in Hin Boun.

Day 4: Exploring Savannakhet's Charm





We'll leave Hin Boun Valley in the morning and head to Savannakhet, a town by the River Mekong. Despite its growing industry, the town has a rural feel, with buffaloes and chickens roaming freely. Before reaching Savannakhet, we'll visit the ancient temple, That Inheng, and enjoy the stunning sunset over the Mekong River.

Day 5: Encountering Wildlife and Local Delights



In central Laos, Savannakhet province showcases a blend of architectural styles influenced by French, Vietnamese, Chinese, and Siamese cultures. Today, we'll begin by visiting the vibrant Savannakhet market to purchase food and fruits for feeding the turtles and monkeys. Our first destination is Nong Papha, a popular spot

featuring a lake and shrine where local children sing traditional songs to call the turtles. Then, we'll explore Dong Lin, known as the "Monkey Forest," nestled amidst rice paddies in Ban Dong Muong. Lunch will be at a local restaurant by a serene lake, providing a unique dining experience **You will stay Overnight at accommodation in Savannakhet.**

Day 6: Scenic journey to Atop the Bolaven Plateau



Today's journey will lead you to the Bolaven Plateau in Southern Laos. Your overnight stay will be at an eco-resort that offers stunning views of the Tad Fane Waterfalls, cascading into a 200-meter deep gorge. The resort provides access to diverse nature trails, including the option to hike up to the Dan Sin Say Plateau. The trek passes through coffee plantations, local villages, and a hanging bridge. This area is home to ethnic tribes such as the Laven, Alak, Katu, and Suay people. You will stay Overnight at the eco-resort accommodation.

Day 7: Discovering Whispers of the Ancient



Following breakfast, we will drive to Champasak to visit the Khmer temple Wat Phu. Later in the day, we will explore Don Khone, an island with Li Phi Falls and remnants of a French railway. **You will stay Overnight on the island.**

Day 8: Exploring Mekong Islands



Done Khone provides captivating insight into the river-centric village lifestyle and offers the chance to catch a glimpse of the elusive Irrawaddy dolphin.

After that, we'll walk between islands and explore some of the four thousand islands scattered across the Mekong River, passing by charming villages where locals make rice paper.

Our overnight stay will be on Khong Island, one of the larger permanently inhabited islands.
